White mirror 4 mm



The white mirror, 4 mm thick, is the most frequently used type of mirror. A 5 mm thick mirror, i.e. stronger than the standard one, is used for much larger sizes and when the mirror could be exposed to greater loads or the risk of damage.

The mirror quality is of great importance, which is why the material from which is made is resistant to corrosive factors in bathrooms - the reflecting layer of silver is protected against moisture. Mirrors can be covered by special protective film to reduce the risk of injury in the event it is broken.

Shape and colour



We also offer coloured mirrors, where body-tinted glass in white, graphite and brown is used. Mirrors with both standard and irregular shapes, such as ellipse, hexagon, triangle, are immensely popular among customers. The maximum size of a white mirror plane is 2550 x 3210 mm.

Edge work, chamfering



Mirror edges can be chamfered, which means a wide decorative cut along the mirror edge, and ground, which means the finishing of the surface of the mirror edge. The edge work is available in two variants: polished or matt, thanks to which the product is characterized by high aesthetic quality.

It is difficult to imagine a bathroom interior without a mirror, which in addition to its practical function, also plays an extremely important role in the room design.


